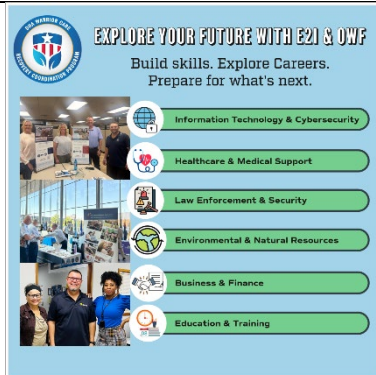

 Warrior Care’s Education and Employment Initiative (E2I) and Operation Warfighter (OWF) programs help recovering service members:


