SUBJECT: System of Record for Non-Clinical Care Coordination: Recovery Care Program-
Support Solution

In accordance with the January 12, 2015, approval by the Deputies Surgeon General, Recovery Care Program-Support Solution (RCP-SS) is now the Department of Defense (DoD) System of Record (SOR) for providing interoperability with the Department of Veteran's Affairs (VA) SOR in support of severely wounded, ill and injured Service members/Veterans for the purposes of electronic transfer and synchronization of non-clinical case management data including the Lead Coordinator Checklist. All DoD processes to electronically transfer non-clinical case management data between the DoD and the VA will be based on the use of RCP-SS as the SOR.
